

Black History Month Art Show at the Library

We are honoring our local artists of color during the month of February by hosting an art show. Submitted artwork does not have to be Afrocentric. You may choose whichever media you would like.

In addition to your work, please provide us with a photo of yourself and a short bio describing your work as an artist. Both items will be displayed along with your artwork.

Due to limited space, there is a size limit. Paintings can be no larger than 30" by 30", while sculptures and other dimensional art should be no larger than 24" by 24" by 24". You can enter no more than 2 works of art per artist for this show.

Applications with art and supporting material can be turned in at the second floor Information Desk beginning Monday, January 24th. Applications and art will be accepted through Monday, February 7th. Art will be displayed on the south side of the second floor through the month of February. You will be responsible for picking up your art by Monday, March 7th. Any unclaimed art will not be stored due to space restrictions.
